

## Saint Anthony Catholic School iPad Agreement

As students are deployed a Saint Anthony Catholic School iPad, it is important for us to finalize the expectations. All students must use their assigned Saint Anthony Catholic School iPad. Devices will have filters and software to allow students to access their textbooks and allow teachers and staff to monitor student actions on the device. iPads used in PK-3rd grade will remain at school.

Please review the rules and regulations as a family. Both parent and student need to sign this acknowledgement in order to receive their device:

- iPads are required to be in a hardcover case at all times.
- Students in 4th through 8th grade are responsible for bringing their device fully charged to school everyday.
- There should never be any food or drink around the iPad.
- Students are not to decorate their iPads, cases or chargers with stickers, markings, etc. in any way.
- Use caution to carefully insert/remove USB cables into/from the iPad to prevent damage.
- Students should not expose the iPad to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for an extended period of time. It may cause permanent damage and shorten the battery life.
- Students should take extreme caution with the screen. The screens are very susceptible to damage from excessive pressure or weight.
- Students are responsible for any damage to the iPad, charger or screen protector. If your iPad, charger or screen protector are damaged, you must report it immediately to your homeroom teacher. Do not attempt to repair your iPad, as that may affect the AppleCare insurance on the device. The corresponding fees will be applied: iPad Repairs:
  - First repair: \$50.
  - o Second repair: \$150.
  - Third and any subsequent repairs, full cost to replace the device.

## Chargers:

- o Apple Lightning to USB Cable (1 m): \$19
- o Apple 12W USB Power Adapter: \$19

Screen Protectors: \$5

- If you lose your iPad, you will have to pay the full cost to replace the device. In the event of theft, a police report must be provided to the Technology Department.
- A loaner device will be issued if a student's device is out for repair. The student must return the loaner upon receipt of their own device.
- If you forget your device, an infraction will be issued. You may check out a loaner for the day. The loaner must be returned by 2:30 pm.
- You must adhere to the Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) in the Family Handbook
- The iPad must remain in the possession of the student to whom it is assigned. The borrowing or exchanging of devices between students is prohibited. Students must not leave the iPad unattended at any time while at school.
- Students who withdraw, are expelled, or who terminate enrollment at Saint Anthony Catholic School for any reason must return the iPad, case, Apple power adapter, and Apple USB cable in working condition to the Technology Department on or before the date of withdrawal.

The administration, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to amend these regulations at any time and also to impose disciplinary action as it deems appropriate. I have read the Saint Anthony Catholic School iPad Agreement and understand the expectations and policies set forth.
